



REPAVING WORK SCHEDULED FOR THE CASTRO AND 18TH STREETS INTERSECTION

Job Order 2124j

Project Description

San Francisco Public Works is scheduled to grind and repave both the 18th and Castro streets intersection and Jane Warner Plaza. Although construction on the project was completed in late 2014, the City has asked the contractor to address some drainage and other deficiencies that are still under warranty. Also, a film crew recently damaged the rainbow crosswalks so we'll be replacing those, as well; the production company will pay for that work.

The nature of the job and the volume of traffic through the area necessitates some night-time work. The work schedule will be as follows:

CASTRO & 18TH INTERSECTION

Monday, September 12 – Grind and pave the 18th and Castro streets intersection. This work will be performed overnight from 7 p.m. until 6 a.m.

Tuesday, September 13 and Wednesday, September 14
The contractor will raise castings (water, sewer, etc.) flush with the street surface. This work is typical after an intersection has been repaved to ensure an even roadway. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Monday, September 19 and Tuesday, September 20
Crews will re-install the four rainbow crosswalks at the 18th and Castro streets intersection. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

JANE WARNER PLAZA

Monday, September 19 through Wednesday, September 21
The contractor will remove and re-install the colored pavement at Jane Warner Plaza. This work will be performed during daytime hours and will take 3 days to complete. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 5 pm.

Impacts and Restrictions

Street parking will not be possible near the work zone during construction work hours. Please see the posted barricade signs for exact work hours, days, and locations, because they will vary depending on the construction task. Vehicles parked in the construction zone during the posted work hours will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

Sidewalk access will be maintained at all times. There may be temporary street closures implemented in order to complete the work and ensure the safety of construction workers. Please allow extra travel time during the posted work hours.

We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience as we make these improvements to San Francisco.

Note: The schedule is subject to change due to equipment breakdown, inclement weather, and unforeseen field conditions.
